2026 Scholarship

Ashland Credit Union believes everyone should have access to an education. We are happy to continue our Scholarship Program for our young members, designed to promote education, achieving more, and owning their journey as they pursue their dreams. Ashland Credit Union will provide ten students \$1,000 each to help finance their higher education pursuits.

Eligibility

Our Scholarship Program is open to the youth of Ashland Credit Union. To qualify, the student must be a member of our credit union or have a family member who is a member in good standing. They must be a graduating senior planning to attend an accredited college, university, or trade school on a full-time basis. Applicants must also have a GPA of 3.0 or above.

Selection

An impartial committee comprised of ACU staff and volunteers will select recipients. Winning students will be notified before the end of the school year. **NOTE: This is a one-time scholarship and all funds are paid towards the first semester of classes.**

Application Process

Interested students must complete this application form and all required items listed below. Upon completion, students may send their scholarship packet to: Scholarship Committee, Ashland Credit Union, 305 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd, Ashland, KY, 41101. You can also email your completed submission to scholarships@ashlandcu.org. Only fully completed applications that meet all requirements will be considered for the scholarship.

3. Essay: Discuss how you became interested in your field or major and describe your experience in the field - such as volunteer work or internships and how you plan on using your education to support your community. Essay must be one page in length and typed or written legibly on 8.5x11 paper.
